Girl With Gun centres on Given Hunter an assassin called, 'Nightingale' with a penchant for helping the innocent. Given, played by a very cute and energetic Tracy O'Connor, struggles with everyday life, best friend Mitch and her unrequiting boyfriend, Dan (no it is not real). The fifteen minute short affords a myriad of filmmaking styles from tender moments to full on action. *Girl With Gun* opens in a rush with a guy laying bleeding on the floor as Given stands over him, while he pleads for his life.

The main action sequence is set outside a Thai restaurant and involves Given and mysterious 'Ninja Girl', played with surprisingly wicked, sadistic exuberance by Asian cutie, Michelle Lee, who was also in, *The Next Action Star*, and did the, *Chicks With Sticks* live shows!
